Mistakes to avoid with masonry work



Align your Unit of Measure

Choose one and then value the contract scope and variations the same way. Don't infect it with 'labour per hour' or do and charge etc. This will control how back charges are applied and keep them in check.

\$ Rate per m2

\$ Rate per brick

Lump sum:

If so include rates for variations [/hr, /m2, /brick]

Variations: Quote either lump or use the contract rate or a rate of some kind

BoC: Do not confuse say this creates a lump sum. A lump sum cannot be divided.

Don't keep re-serving unpaid claims

This will use up reference dates.

Do NOT email multiple invoices as a single claim. Instead, create a single claim out of them.

You can only serve one claim per reference date.
